Kevin Culjat Named Saint Albert Head Football Coach

Saint Albert Catholic Schools announced today that Kevin Culjat has been named the school's head football coach. Culjat replaces Jim Duggan, who resigned from the position in early April to take a coaching and teaching job in Duncanville, Texas.

Culjat has served as the defensive coordinator for Saint Albert since 2001, helping lead the team to state championships in 2006 and 2007. He was an assistant football coach for Abraham Lincoln High School in 1999 and 2000, and served as an offensive and defensive line coach at Saint Albert from 1996-1999.

Prior to coaching in Council Bluffs, he was an assistant football coach at Summit High School in Breckenridge, Colo., from 1990-1994.

In addition to coaching football, Culjat also has served as the Freshman baseball coach at Saint Albert for the past two years and as a varsity baseball coach from 1997-1999.

Culjat is a 1982 graduate of Saint Albert. When he assumes his position, he will take over a successful program that he helped build. Saint Albert made Council Bluffs history by winning three state championships (2004, 2006 and 2007) in four years. The school also was the state football runner-up in 2003 and has advanced to state playoff competition for 12 consecutive years.

"The Saint Albert football program has a long and proud tradition of excellence and I am very pleased to serve in the head coaching position," Culjat said. "I look forward to working with such a high caliber of assistant coaches and players to carry on the tradition."
